

RESOLUTION NO. 965

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LYNDEN, WASHINGTON, SETTING THE DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE LYNDEN CITY COUNCIL'S INTENT TO ASSUME THE RIGHTS, POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE LYNDEN TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT, ON APRIL 1, 2017 AS ALLOWED BY CHAPTER 36.74 REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lynden adopted Ordinance No. 1423 creating the Lynden Transportation Benefit District with the same boundaries as the City limits;

WHEREAS, RCW 36.74.010 provides that "[a]ny city or county in which a transportation benefit district has been established pursuant to chapter 36.73 RCW with boundaries coterminous with the boundaries of the city or county may by ordinance or resolution of the city or county legislative authority assume the rights, powers, functions, and obligations of the transportation benefit district in accordance with this chapter"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lynden is required to identify the time, date and place for a public hearing on the proposed assumption of the rights, powers, functions and obligations of the Lynden Transportation Benefit District will take place; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LYNDEN CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Hearing Date


The City of Lynden Council will hold a public hearing on the proposed assumption of the rights, powers, functions and obligation of the Lynden Transportation Benefit District on March 20, 2017 at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting which is held at the City Annex at 205 4th Street. All persons interested may appear and be heard.

Section 2. Publication

This Resolution shall be published in the Lynden Tribune two times during the two weeks preceding the scheduled hearing.


