

ORDINANCE NO. 1371

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNDEN
SETTING SALARIES OF ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS
AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1343**

The City Council of the City of Lynden does ordain as follows:

Section A. Salaries of elected and appointed City officials of the City of Lynden shall be as follows, effective January 1, 2010.

1. The salary of the Mayor shall be EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$1,800.00) per month. In addition the Mayor shall receive a car allowance of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$150.00) per month.
2. The salary of City Council members shall be TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100^{THS} DOLLARS (\$200.00) per regular or special meeting of the City Council; provided that, City Council members shall not be compensated for more than thirty-six (36) meetings per calendar year; provided further however, that City Council members shall be paid for up to two (2) meetings per year which they are unable to attend, within the thirty-six (36) meeting compensation limit.
3. The salary of the City Administrator shall be NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SIX AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$9,326.00) per month. In addition the City Administrator shall receive a car allowance of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$250.00) per month.
4. The salary of the Finance Director shall be SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$7,359.00) per month.
5. The salary of the Chief of Police shall be as determined in the collective bargaining agreement.
6. The salary of the Public Works Director shall be SEVEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$7,897.00) per month.
7. The salary of the Parks and Recreation Director shall be SIX THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$6,741.00) per month.
8. The salary of the Planning Director shall be SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN AND NO/100TH DOLLARS (\$6,867.00) per month.
9. The salary of the Fire Chief shall be SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETY AND NO/100^{THS} DOLLARS (\$7,390.00) per month.
10. The salary of the City Attorney shall be as set by contract with the City.
11. Salaries of employees represented by a bargaining agent shall be as determined in the collective bargaining agreement.
12. Salaries of persons not otherwise listed in this ordinance shall be as set by the City Council from time to time.

Section B. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this code and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences,

clauses or phrases have been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if, for any reason, this ordinance should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original ordinance or ordinances shall be in full force and effect.

Section C. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section D. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


