

RESOLUTION NO. 882

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LYNDEN, WHATCOM COUNTY, WASHINGTON TO SEGREGATE AN EXISTING ASSESSMENT IN UTILITY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2008-01 PURSUANT TO SECTION 35.44.410 OF THE REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, the City of Lynden has received written application attached as Exhibit A from the property owner requesting segregation of the original assessment on property within Utility Local Improvement District No. 2008-01; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.44.410 authorizes the City Council to order the segregation of local improvement district assessments whenever property subject to such assessment is subdivided or otherwise altered by a boundary line adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the parcel affected by this segregation is identified as Whatcom County Assessor's parcel number 400224-543131-0000; and

WHEREAS, this segregation will continue to preserve the security of outstanding district debt obligations by reapportioning the existing assessment balances to the new taxable parcel as recorded by the Whatcom County Assessor's Office.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lynden City Council as follows:

Section 1: Segregation shall be made to the assessment roll of Utility Local Improvement District No. 2008-01 that was confirmed and adopted by Ordinance No. 1325 on August 4, 2008; and

Section 2: That the assessment shall result in amended assessments as shown in the table attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as Exhibit C.

Section 3: The sum of the amended assessments shall exactly equal the amount of the original assessment before segregation.
