Following is rate classification information:

1. Single Family shall include Mobile Homes.
2. Business/Commercial/Industrial (Non-Permit) covers all non-residential uses, including: Offices and Retail Stores, Churches, Recreation Centers, Service/Gas Stations, Fairgrounds, Hotels/Motels, Nursing Homes, Assisted Living Facilities (without full kitchens, including oven and cooktop), Food and Beverage Establishments, Laundromats, Car Washes, and Schools, and Industries which the City has determined do not require an NPDES Permit.
3. Grounds services shall be for all non-potable uses, including irrigation.

All disconnect fees will apply whether voluntary or in relation to a non-paid utility bill. Temporary disconnects and/or reconnects (vacationers, tenant changes, etc.) will continue to pay a base water fee, full storm fee and one-half (50%) of the sewer fee.

*** **Residential Outside City Limits Multiplier on Base Rate; Commercial outside City Limits Multiplier on Base Rate and Unit Volume; and installation of flow meter(s) will be required.**

The following penalties shall be implemented for Industrial Permitted Users:

- A non-representative sample will be billed as if 100% of the Daily Maximum Demand was delivered.
- If an Industrial User exceeds the permit limit for Flow, BOD or TSS; it will result in a rate 3-times the established per unit rate for each violation over the permit or contract limit.
- A ph reading outside the permit limit will result in a rate 3-times the established rate for flow for the period of violation.
- A concentration level in mg/l over the permit or contract level will result in a rate 3-times the established per unit rate for the permit or contract charge.

Any industrial user that falls into any of the categories below, is considered a Significant Industrial User and needs an NPDES permit before connecting to the City's system:

1. All industrial users subject to categorical pretreatment standard under 40 CFR 403.6 and 40 CFR Chapter 1, Subchapter N;
2. Discharges an average of 25,000 gallons per day or more of process wastewater to the City sewer system (excluding sanitary, noncontact cooling, and boiler blow-down wastewater); or
3. Contributes a process waste stream that makes up 5% or more of the average dry weather hydraulic or organic (BOD) capacity; or
4. Is designated by the Washington State Department of Ecology as having a reasonable potential for adversely affecting the City's treatment operations or for violating any pretreatment standard or requirement in accordance with 40 CFR 403.8 (f)(6). Per Lynden Municipal Code Section 13

Following is rate classification information:

1. Business/Commercial/Industrial (Non-Permit) covers all non-residential uses, including: Offices and Retail Stores, Churches, Recreation Centers, Service/Gas Stations, Fairgrounds, Hotels/Motels, Nursing Homes, Assisted Living Facilities (without full kitchens, including oven and cooktop), Food and Beverage Establishments, Laundromats, Car Washes, Schools, and Industries which the City has determined do not require an NPDES Permit.
2. Multi-Family shall include apartments, duplexes, Independent Living Facilities, and multiple condominium units served by a single meter.
